This will help you maintain order in your home base of manuals. Put the fax machine near a telephone wall jack and a standard, grounded AC power outlet. Lets you access the menu to program and store your settings in the fax machine. These are quiet, in terms of noise every 4 seconds. You'll hear them after you dial and press Fax Start and they will continue for about 60 seconds after dialing. Connect the telephone's line cord to the jack labeled EXT. Tap the stack of papers so the edges are even. User friendly programming helps you take full advantage of all the menu selections the fax machine has to offer. When you enter the menu, the LCD scrolls. SETUP SEND Continued 7. To enter a space in the name, press twice between characters.

Making corrections If you entered a letter incorrectly and want to change it, press to move the cursor under the incorrect character. The default factor setting is LOW. Press or to adjust the volume level. The LCD shows your current selection. 2 Continue to press Receive Mode until your new selection appears. The preset Fax Receive Code is 51. Some ring patterns cannot be registered. The ring patterns below are supported by the Brother machine. Caller ID After a few rings, the LCD shows the telephone number of your caller and name if available. This could be useful if you are sending a fax with photos and text, or some pages with small print and others with larger print. Your cover page includes the name or number stored in the On Touch or Speed Dial memory. If you are dialing manually, the name is left blank. You can use the handset to make calls. Be sure to cut out the Remote Retrieval Access Card on the last page and keep it with you at all times. When you call the fax machine and enter your Remote Access Code 3 digits followed by , the system will give two short beeps and you must enter a remote command. Also, a journal of sent and received faxes can be printed at specified intervals. For example, press 6 to print the USER SETTINGS. Always make sure you have paper in the paper tray before making copies. Copy operations To make a single copy that is not reduced, enlarged or sorted, you only have to press one key. First, you can select the number of copies. If this happens, your fax machine identifies the problem and displays an error message. The most common error messages are shown below. Open the top cover and remove any foreign obstacles from inside the fax machine.
